1	SECTION 1. USE OF MEMBERS' REPRESENTATIONAL AL-
2	LOWANCE TO CONTINUE PROVIDING SERV-
3	ICES FOR CASEWORK PROJECTS FOR
4	FORMER CONSTITUENTS AFFECTED BY RE-
5	DISTRICTING.
6	(a) USE OF ALLOWANCE.—Section 101 of the House
7	of Representatives Administrative Reform Technical Cor-
8	rections Act (2 U.S.C. 5341) is amended—
9	(1) by redesignating subsections (c) through (e)
10	as subsections (d) through (f); and
11	(2) by inserting after subsection (b) the fol-
12	lowing new subsection:
13	"(c) Use for Continuing Casework Services
14	FOR CERTAIN FORMER CONSTITUENTS.—If a Member of
15	the House of Representatives provides services for a case-
16	work project on behalf of an individual who is a con-
17	stituent of the Member during a Congress but who is not
18	a constituent during a succeeding Congress, the provision
19	of casework services for that project on behalf of that indi-
20	vidual by the Member during the first session of the suc-
21	ceeding Congress shall be considered as part of the Mem-
22	ber's official and representational duties during the first
23	session of the succeeding Congress for purposes of this
24	section if the individual would have been a constituent
25	during the succeeding Congress but for the enactment of
26	a congressional redistricting plan.".

(b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
subsection (a) shall apply with respect to services provided
during the One Hundred Seventeenth Congress and any
succeeding Congress.
